# MIPS Extreme and Uncontrollable Circumstances Policy Reminder

- For 2018, MIPS ECs and groups affected by extreme and uncontrollable circumstances may submit a request for reweighting of all MIPS categories
  - Extreme and uncontrollable circumstances would cause you to be unable to collect information necessary to submit for a performance category, or to submit information that would be used to score a performance category for an extended period of time (for example, 3 months unable to collect data for the Quality performance category).
  - Intended to address those affected by recent natural disasters
- The deadline to submit a request for 2018 is <u>December 31, 2018</u>

### 2019 Final Rule

- The Final Rule on the Quality Payment Program (QPP) 2019 was released on November 1, 2018
- The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) are focusing on:
  - Reducing clinician burden
  - Identifying "meaningful" measures for the program
  - Ramping up requirements across components
  - Restructuring the Promoting Interoperability component

## **2019 MIPS Eligibility**


- Do you have to report MIPS?
  - Not first year enrolled in Medicare
  - Not significantly participating in Advanced APMs
  - Exceeds Low Volume Threshold new criterion added

#### 2018

Bills at least **\$90,000** Medicare Part B charges

#### **AND**

Sees **200** Medicare Part B patients in a year



#### 2019

Bills at least **\$90,000** Medicare Part B charges

#### **AND**

sees 200 Medicare Part B patients in a year

#### **AND**

Provides **200** or more covered professional services under the Physician Fee Schedule (PFS)

### **Opting-In**

- Clinicians and groups that meet or exceed at least ONE of the low-volume threshold criteria, but not all have the opportunity to "opt-in" to MIPS beginning in 2019
- Those who choose to opt-in are subject to positive, neutral and negative payment adjustments
- Voluntary Reporting: If clinicians or groups do not meet any of the low-volume threshold criteria they can report MIPS voluntarily, however they will NOT be eligible for a payment adjustment

Bills at least **\$90,000**Medicare Part B charges

#### **AND**


sees **200** Medicare Part B patients in a year

#### **AND**

Provides **200** or more covered professional services under the Physician Fee Schedule (PFS)

### **2019 MIPS Components**

- Quality Component weight continues to decrease
- Cost Component still not applicable to most anesthesia providers
- Improvement Activities requirements remain unchanged
- Advancing Care Information (ACI) rebranded to Promoting Interoperability (PI)
- Payment adjustment + / 7%
- Component weights may change based on clinician special status



### **Quality Component – Anesthesiology Set**

The 2019 MIPS Anesthesiology Measure Set was finalized to include 7 measures:

- 1. MIPS #44: CABG: Preoperative Beta-Blocker in Patients with Isolated CABG Surgery
- MIPS #76: Prevention of CVC-Related Bloodstream Infections\*
- 3. MIPS #402: Tobacco Use and Help with Quitting Among Adolescents
- 4. MIPS #404: Anesthesiology Smoking Abstinence\* (Intermediate Outcome)
- 5. MIPS #424: Perioperative Temperature Management\* (Outcome)
- 6. MIPS #426: Post-Anesthetic Transfer of Care Measure: Procedure Room to PACU\* REMOVED
- 7. MIPS #427: Post-Anesthetic Transfer of Care Measure: Procedure Room to ICU\* REMOVED
- 8. MIPS #430: Prevention of PONV Combination Therapy\*
- 9. MIPS #463: Prevention of Post-Operative Vomiting (POV) Combination Therapy (Pediatrics)\*

<sup>\*</sup> designates a "high priority" measure

# Performance Threshold and Payment Adjustment

### 2018

15 point threshold

Exceptional performer at 70 points

Payment adjustment at +/- 5%



#### 2019

30 point threshold

Exceptional performer at 75 points

Payment adjustment at +/- 7%


### **Arbor Metrix Updates**

- Arbor Metrix has released provider list updates to better assist AQI champions in accurately updating their provider lists
- When selecting a single provider from a provider list, AQI champions now have the ability to select one of the following provider "status"

**Active:** Provider is active or was active for the quality reporting year

#### Inactive:

**Removed:** Provider is no longer at practice, has no data to submit



### **Facility List Audits**

- The AQI facility list audit is still in progress
  - We are aiming to reduce the number of unused and duplicate facilities in order to clean up the benchmarking data
- Facility lists are important because it allows AQI champions to review benchmarking data and view performance of the practice facilities

### **Data File Email Reminders**

- AQI began sending email notification reminders to AQI champions in October
- Reminders will be sent every other week until the final deadline (2/15/19)
- Notifies AQI champions if no data files have been submitted to NACOR for 2018 or a new data file has been uploaded.
  - If a new file has been uploaded review the NACOR dashboard prior to deadlines so you have an opportunity to review any errors and correct them in a timely manner
- Please contact your AQI Account Manager if you have any questions or would like to review your dashboard results.

- Services are available for practices who need merging, formatting or both merging and formatting of their data files.
- Registration deadline is 12/15/18
