

- 15% of Final MIPS Score
- Check your special status for reporting requirements.
- At least 50% of the clinicians in the group must perform the same activity during any continuous 90day period.
- Identify your IAs early in the year to ensure a 90-day period is available.

Opting In vs. Voluntary Reporting

- You can opt-in to MIPS if you are an eligible clinician or group who exceeds 1 or 2 (but not all 3) of the low-volume threshold criteria during either review period. If you are an eligible clinician or group who opts-in to MIPS, you will receive a MIPS final score in 2022 and a payment adjustment in 2023.
- You can voluntarily report if you are a clinician or group that is not MIPS eligible. If you report voluntarily, you will receive a MIPS final score but no payment adjustment.






Provider List Update




- Updating your list makes your practice reports easier to understand, clears up clutter and assists with the reconciliation billing process that will occur after the new year
 - Provider names are not submitted in the data so the names must be entered manually
- Provider Status
 - Active
 - Inactive Providers that are on a temporary leave and will be coming back to the practice
 - Remove- Providers that have retired or are no longer with the practice
