<input type="checkbox"/> <p><b>Attest to Improvement Activities</b>      <b>Due 2/15/18</b></p> <p>MIPS Improvement Activities is a scored category that aims to reward ECs for activities, such as care coordination, beneficiary engagement and patient safety.</p> <p><b><i>Improvement Activities account for 15 percent of the total MIPS Composite Score</i></b> in performance year 2017 and beyond.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Each activity is assigned a medium or high weight. Medium activities receive 10 points and high activities receive 20 points. <input type="checkbox"/> <p><b>Pick Your Pace Option</b>      <b>Due 2/15/18</b></p> <p><b><i>Partial Year Reporting</i></b> (90 consecutive days): Enter the date range of your 90 days in the NACOR Dashboard.</p> <p><b><i>Test (1 case/1 measure) or Full Year</i></b> Reporting: No NACOR Dashboard updates required.</p>	<p><a href="#">Selecting your 90-day reporting period in the NACOR Dashboard</a></p>
<input type="checkbox"/> <p><b>Reconcile Provider Lists</b>      <b>Due 2/15/18</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Review the accuracy of the TIN, NPIs and staff role (e.g. MD, CRNA, DO, AA, Resident)</li> <li>Select “YES” to report this provider’s data to CMS.</li> </ul>	<p><a href="#">Updating your Practice Provider List</a></p>
<input type="checkbox"/> <p><b>Provider Consents</b>      <b>Due 2/28/18</b></p> <p>Eligible clinicians (ECs) must return consent forms by Wednesday, February 28. Data cannot legally be submitted to CMS without a consent form.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>ECs received an email from ArborMetrix in December with a link to an EC-specific electronic consent form. The email subject line from <a href="mailto:nacormessaging@arbormetrix.com">nacormessaging@arbormetrix.com</a> was “CMS requirement: Consent needed for NACOR individual quality reporting.”</li> </ul> <p><b>If consents are not submitted by February 28, quality data will not be sent to CMS.</b> For questions about consents, email <a href="#">Margaret Bussan</a>.</p>
