<input type="checkbox"/> Attest to Improvement Activities Due 2/15/19 For 2018, Improvement Activities is a scored category of MIPS that aims to reward ECs for engaging in activities such as care coordination, beneficiary engagement and patient safety. Improvement Activities account for 15 percent of the total MIPS Composite Score in performance year 2018 and beyond. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each activity is assigned a weight of either medium or high. Medium activities receive 10 points and high activities receive 20 points. To receive full credit, ECs must receive a score of 40 points or more. <input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Provider Consents Due 2/28/19</p> <p>Eligible clinicians (ECs) who are enrolled in 2018 individual quality reporting must return consent forms by Wednesday, February 28, as required by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• ECs of practices that elected to receive electronic consents received an email from ArborMetrix in December with a link to an EC-specific electronic consent form. The email subject line from nacormessaging@arbormetrix.com was "CMS requirement: Consent needed for NACOR individual quality reporting." <p>If consents are not submitted by February 28, quality data will not be sent to CMS.</p> <p>For questions about consents, email Margaret Bussan.</p>
