Start quality reporting with help from 2017 NACOR User Guide

AQI released this week the [2017 NACOR User Guide](#), which includes detailed information about submitting data to AQI's National Anesthesia Clinical Outcomes Registry (NACOR). The guide outlines quality reporting options, mechanisms and 2017 deadlines, as well as NACOR minimum data field requirements and sample data collection forms.

SAMBA members eligible to participate in NACOR

AQI has partnered with the Society for Ambulatory Anesthesia (SAMBA) to offer its members reduced participation rates for AQI's NACOR, designated as a Qualified Registry (QR) and a Qualified Clinical Data Registry (QCQR) by CMS. Under the agreement, SAMBA members can participate in NACOR Basic, Standard NACOR Quality Reporting or NACOR Quality Concierge. This arrangement will help to further position NACOR as the quality reporting tool of choice among anesthesia clinicians. 2017 NACOR Quality Reporting renewal process

The 2017 NACOR Quality Reporting online order and renewal process is underway. Enroll in NACOR Quality Reporting by completing the new [online order form](#).

- **Reminder:** Practices electing the partial year reporting option for MIPS must report on six measures, including one outcome measure, for 90 consecutive days to earn a neutral or small positive payment adjustment.
