FINAL 2017 NACOR Quality Reporting Registration and renewal deadline is October 31

Importance of submitting appropriate measure codes

When preparing your NACOR data submission, carefully review the CPT codes within the denominator of each measure against the CPT codes that you bill. AQI'S NACOR can only evaluate CPT codes included in the specifications for each measure. For example, if a given measure requires ASA CPT codes, NACOR cannot evaluate surgical CPT codes for that measure. If appropriate CPT codes are not submitted, NACOR cannot calculate the measures a practice intends on reporting.
